Call for a volunteer Children and Youth Protection Officer 4th WFDYS Children Camp

The World Federation of the Deaf Youth Section (WFDYS) are looking for a volunteer to work as a '**Children and Youth Protection Officer (CYPO)**' at the 4th WFDYS Children Camp in Buenos Aires, Argentina from 6th – 14th April, 2018.

The successful candidate should have some competency in International Sign, experience from children camp(s) and is a qualified, trained 'safety' officer for children and youth protection.

Duties:

- To provide safety training to the World Federation of the Deaf Youth Section board members and the Camp Organising Committee (COC) prior to the camp starting. This will take place on the camp-site.
- During the camp, the Children and Youth Protection Officer will monitor the safety of the children and be the point of contact in any situation that requires attention.

Time commitment:

- Provide a (1) full day of training to the WFDYS board and COC members.
- Full time duty during the hours the children will be awake during the camp.
- Overnight duty, if a situation arises, the candidate will be expected to get up and attend to the situation.

Qualifications

- Proof of training in any capacity of children and youth safety (you will be required to show a certificate of attendance for the training for Children and Youth protection awareness and/or training to be a safeguard officer or any similar training. Please provide evidence of your training and its content).
- Proof of experience in any children or youth camps.
- Proof of knowledge of international sign (a short signed video in International Sign).

Support

- The WFDYS President and COC Chair will work alongside with you if a situation arises.

The successful applicant will be provided with a return ticket to Buenos Aires, travel insurance and his/her possible Visa fees will be covered. In addition, lodging and meals will be offered by WFDYS. However, this is a voluntary position, which means the work cannot be paid but a written reference will be provided at the end of the camp.
